The tracks New Butler to Belton and Wiscona will be operated by the Madison Division and trains will be governed by automatic block signals and the rules and regulations of the Madison Division Time Table.

Rule 83A does not apply to trains operating under Milwaukee District Terminal Time Table, except that trains will obtain Clearance Form A at Milwaukee Passenger Station and New Butler.

No. 103 will not operate Monday, June 9th; Wednesday, June 11th; Thursday, June 12th; and after Saturday, September 6th, will operate only on Tuesday, September 9th and 16th, and Friday, September 12th and 19th, 1930.
