In the through Interline Service the column headed "day" showing specific days of the week is for the purpose of example only to indicate the elapsed time between various points and has no connection with the days on which the trains operate. Only a few of the key points on other lines are shown and are for examples only. In some instances all of the routes beyond the New Haven's immediate connections may not be indicated.


