This book showing regular Freight Train schedules on the New Haven Railroad and interline service via connecting lines is for the information of shippers and receivers of freight.

The times and trains shown are not guaranteed and are subject to change without notice. Schedules of other railroads are shown as information only. No responsibility is assumed for errors or changes.

Freight stations are not regularly open for transaction of business on Saturdays, Sundays or Legal Holidays, and freight service is curtailed accordingly.

If Saturday, Sunday or Holiday service is desired on Car Load freight, advance arrangements should be made through Local Freight Agent.

Passenger equipped refrigerators in freight service are restricted to movement on rear end of trains, regardless of classification, and normally advertised schedules under such circumstances do not apply.

**INTERLINE SERVICE**

In the through Interline Service the column headed "day" showing specific days of the week is for the purpose of example only to indicate the elapsed time between various points and has no connection with the days on which the trains operate. Only a few of the key points on other lines are shown and are for examples only. In some instances all of the routes beyond the New Haven's immediate connections may not be indicated.

**EXPLANATION OF TRAIN SYMBOLS**

Trains running under symbol designation are known as "symbol trains". The symbol is a letter-and-number combination for identification purposes indicating either initial or final terminal, or both.

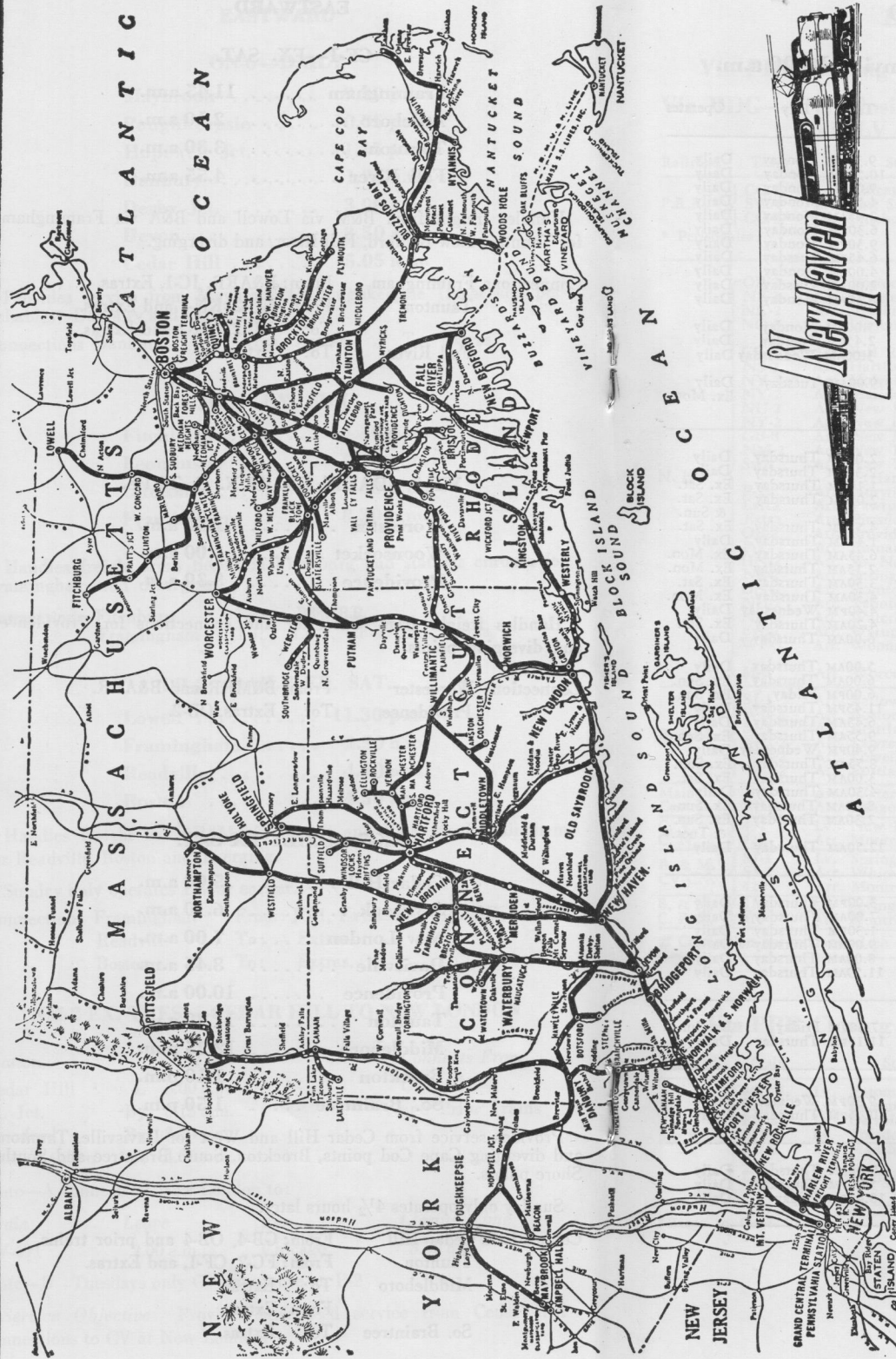

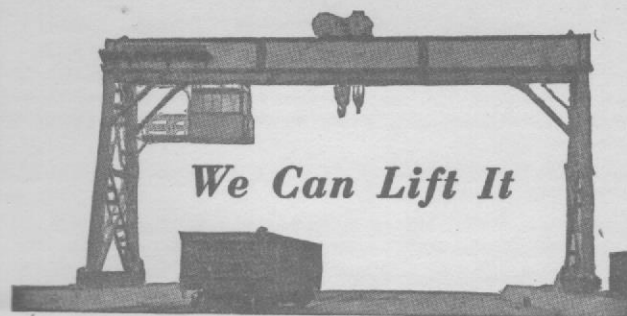
