INSTRUCTIONS GOVERNING THE RATING OF ENGINES.

- 1. Engines will haul the tonnage for which they are rated.
- 2. Ratings shown herein for engines of K-1-b type are for superheated engine; saturated engine of same type should be rated 10% less. Rating shown for K-1 engines should be used for K-1-a, K-1-b and K-1-c saturated steam engines. Class K-2 and P-1 engines, where no rating is shown, will be rated as follows: K-2, 2 cars, 100 tons less than K-1. P-1, 2 cars, 100 tons more than K-1.
- 3. Mixed trains or branch-line trains, where the entire service is performed by one crew, such as between Amston and Colchester, shall be classed as Local Freight trains.
- 4. Ratings have been fixed for slow and local freight service only. Fast freights will handle "B," "C," or "D" rating as directed.
- 5. All perishable and merchandise shall move in arranged service. Freight such as coal, pig iron billets, grain, lumber, wool, or freight not requiring fast movement shall move in "slow freight" trains. "Fast freight" and "local freight" trains must fill out to required rating with low freight cars.
- 6. Weight of cars must be figured in tons of 2000 pounds each. Fractions of tons are not to be used; less than one-half a ton will not be considered; one-half a ton or more will be counted a full ton.
- 7. When the actual weight of shipments of L. C. L. freight cannot be obtained, it will be estimated at six and one-half $(6\frac{1}{2})$ tons plus light weight of car.
- 8. Before trains leave terminals, gross tonnage will be computed by the agent, yardmaster or other representative, and by conductor. Engine must be given full rating if there are cars enough to do so. Trains, except arranged service, should not be run until there are enough cars to furnish full rating.
- 9. Conductors, or yard clerks must enter combined weight of car and lading in tons; also weight of empty cars in tons, in the space provided on wheel report Form 1331, and in train book Form 1440. Conductors will add the tonnage shown on their wheel reports and see that the total agrees with the total in train book Form 1440. The entries in train book must be made to agree with yardmaster's record before leaving terminal.
- 10. Conductors, or yard clerks must show on wheel report Form 1331, under "kind of train," whether "fast," "slow," or "local freight."
- 11. Agents or yardmasters will report to the chief train dispatcher immediately after the departure of each train, the actual number of tons, cars and lading hauled by each train, and show reason for trains departing with tonnage less or more than rating.
- 12. No deviation from the listed engine rating will be made without the authority of the superintendent or Chief Train Dispatcher, except in cases when the engineman having hauled the train a sufficient distance and finding that the engine will not handle it, will notify the conductor the number of cars he desires to set out. Conductors will promptly comply

and set out cars that will suffer least from the detention, and notify the chief train dispatcher by wire, giving number of cars, class of freight, destinations and tons in train before and after setting out. Enginemen will notify the chief train dispatcher by wire, giving reasons for reducing tonnage. All instances of this nature must be fully investigated by the chief train dispatcher, and a record kept to enable him to explain the reasons or failure to move the full engine rating over his division.

- 13. When light weight is not stenciled on cars, weight should be estimated in accordance with instructions on back of Freight Conductors Wheel Report.
- 14. Dispatchers will note on the rosters the atmospheric temperature at hourly intervals when temperature is below 32° F.
- 15. Rating shown as "including helping service" is based upon helper and head engine being of the same class. When helper used is smaller than head engine, their combined rating is the sum of one-half of the stated rating for each class. When helper is used and rating does not include helping service, the combined rating is the sum of the ratings for head engine and helper.

EQUATED RATING OF ENGINES.

Rating for each class of engine shows load that should be handled and number of cars for that rating when temperature is above 32 degrees F.

Tonnage ratings shall be equalized as follows (for purpose of equating for varying resistance of cars of different weights):

LOW GRADE ROUTES.

Add 12 tons to the rating for each car less than normal number. Likewise subtract 12 tons for each car more than normal number.

HIGH GRADE ROUTES.

Add 8 tons to the rating for each car less than normal number. Likewise subtract 8 tons for each car more than normal number.

The following routes shall be considered "High Grade," all other routes "Low Grade":

Between Maybrook and Readville, via Waterbury.

Between Maybrook and Hartford, via Canaan.

Between Maybrook and New Haven.

Between Bridgeport and Pittsfield.

Example. — If normal rating is 2500 tons in 50 cars, rating would increase or decrease according to the number of cars in train, as follows:

Single motors should be limited to fifty (50) cars either loaded or empty regardless of tonnage.

When necessary to reduce tonnage on account of weather or other conditions, temperature rating as indicated will govern where temperature conditions only apply.

Where snow, ice or other unfavorable conditions apply, lower stated rating will be used by Superintendents for the trip or day.

Normal ratings will apply when the temperature is 33 degrees F. or more above zero; B rating when the temperature is 20 to 32 degrees F. above zero; C rating when temperature is 5 to 19 degrees F. above zero; D and E ratings will be used only as authorized by the Superintendent.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Regular freight trains are shown herein and will be run as arranged, performing the work outlined, AND NO CHANGE IN THIS ARRANGED SERVICE WILL BE MADE EXCEPT BY AUTHORITY OF SUPERINTENDENT OF TRANSPORTATION.
- 2. All freight trains handling perishable and time freight, such as pier trains, boat freight trains and time freights, will be designated by a symbol to distinguish them from extra trains run for local or slow freight; they may, for convenience in handling, be scheduled on time-table on single track.
- 3. All regular freight trains handling mixed classes of freight, such as way-freights, drop and pick-up trains, road switchers, etc., will be given an approximate schedule and be designated as "extra," except that on single track they may be shown on timetable for convenience in operation.
 - 4. Slow freight trains will run extra as the business demands.
- 5. Nothing contained herein confers track, running or time-table rights to any train.
- 6. Train dispatchers must see that the trains specified herein are run as set forth, and handle the class of freight for which they are arranged. They must see that the symbol trains have preference over all extra or irregular freight trains, and that the arranged extra trains follow as near as possible the times as arranged herein. They will keep connecting divisions, junction points and yards fully informed as to the movement of the trains and the number of cars they are to drop or pick up, that they may be prepared to handle the train without delay.
- 7. Freight agents must fully acquaint themselves with the time these arranged trains are due at their station as well as the class of business they are to handle and have freight ready to avoid delay, and will keep the train dispatcher advised as to the number of cars to be forwarded or the number of cars left over by these trains.
- 8. Yardmasters will familiarize themselves with the character of these trains and see that they handle the business for which they are intended, and where trains terminate they must see that cars going beyond make proper connection. They will see that yard conductors are supplied with a copy of this arranged service, and that they fully understand the train arrangement, both as to the nature of the work and schedule; they will notify freight conductors of the proper symbol for the train they are to run, that proper notice may be given to the enginemen as well as to the chief train dispatcher.
- 9. Freight conductors will be furnished with a copy of this arranged service and must thoroughly inform themselves as to the requirements of same; they must ascertain from the yardmasters the symbol of the train they are to run before leaving initial point, and use same on their wheel report, form 1331, and the "Q-7" report. They must notify enginemen before starting as to the symbol under which the train is run.
- 10. The trains herein are arranged to care for a normal freight business and when cars offering are in excess of the limit of the trains, sections or extras will be run if the overflow justifies, and when sections are run they must be given the same movement as the regular arranged trains.
- 11. The time as shown for this arranged service is approximate and may be varied from slightly to meet road conditions. Agents and yardmasters should keep themselves fully informed as to the movement of the service and have their cars or freight ready in case they should reach their station or yard slightly in advance of the arranged time.
- 12. If the business offering for trains arranged to handle perishable and time freight does not equal the hauling capacity of the engine, they should be filled out to the engine rating with slow freight; but in adding slow freight to time, pier or boat freights, it must be cut out en route when necessary to make room for perishable and time freight to be picked up.

EXPLANATION OF TRAIN SYMBOLS

Trains running under symbol designation are known as "symbol trains." The symbol is a letter-and-number combination indicating where the train is from and its destination, and is used for the purpose of identity.

The first letter of the symbol signifies the initial or starting point of train and the second letter indicates the final destination of train and the numbers are used to distinguish one symbol from another.

The even numbers following the symbol indicate east or northward trains and the odd numbers indicate south or westward trains; viz., H-B 2 is an eastward train running from Harlem River to Boston, and B-H 3 is a westward train running from Boston to Harlem River and as the business calls for a section of a symbol train, the section will be represented the same as that of a regular schedule thus, 2d H-B 2 or 3d B-H 3.
