# **FOREWORD**

In PRESENTING this booklet I should like to state at the outset that it is not in any sense an official document. That a more complete list of "honor" farms along the C. & E. I. R. R. and a more accurate list of progressive farmers is possible is freely admitted.

We sought the information largely through our agents and our inquiries were, in many cases, either misunderstood or the information furnished so incomplete as to render the data provided without value for the purpose intended, which is, of course, only co-operative.

Nothing is of more interest to the C. & E. I. R. R. than the agricultural development of the territory it serves and the welfare of the farmers. Many of our officers themselves are farm owners and for this reason, if no other, are fully appreciative of the farmers' problems and desirous of assisting in solving them.

In this spirit, therefore, the information presented herein was compiled. It was felt that it would be helpful to C. & E. I. farmers to know what their neighors up and down the line are doing. It was thought it would be particularly beneficial to have a tabulation—even tho incomplete—of those farmers having a surplus of registered or blooded stock or dependable seeds for sale—so that exchange might be arranged at the minimum of risk and expense and the maximum of profit to all concerned.

If the information in this booklet serves in any way to bring our farmers closer together in a co-operative way; if it leads to visits, to exchange of correspondence or views between farmers not heretofore acquainted, we shall, indeed, feel amply rewarded for the effort expended. As this incomplete list amply demonstrates, there are many farms along the C. & E. I. which are an inspiration and delight to the man who wants to succeed as a farmer—and I am quite certain that none will be more quick with their aid; none more ready to lend their best advice and assistance, than the proprietors of those successful farms to those ambitious to succeed.

Unquestionably the successful farmer is he who increases his crops by improving his soil, and with many even experienced farmers this means a step out into the realm of crop-diversification, live-stock husbandry, etc., where the best advice is not too good and where a practical demonstration and actual view of results accomplished is superior to any possible treatise or theoretical instruction.

I wish to extend thanks to those bankers and others who assisted so materially in securing farm information and if an "Association of C. & E. I. Farmers" is organized, there are many honorary officers who have qualified for recognition.
