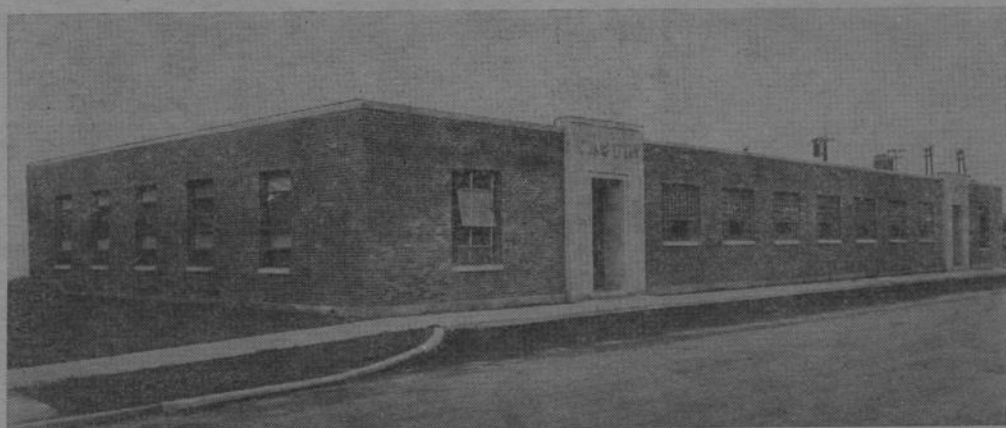
Introduction

The Chicago Aurora and Elgin Railway is a common carrier, electrically operated railway, serving the suburban territory west of Chicago, Illinois, its rail line beginning at Des Plaines Avenue, Forest Park, Illinois. It extends westerly to Wheaton, Illinois, with branch lines to the cities of Aurora, Illinois (Pop. 50,576), and Elgin, Illinois (Pop. 44,223), in the Fox River Valley. The territory served is through fast growing residential and industrial property.

The C. A. & E. Ry. gives fast, frequent and dependable local and interline carload freight service, and is a connecting link between Eastern and Western trunk line carriers having direct interchange connections with major railroads at seven locations. A total of 40 diversified industries are being served directly by the C. A. & E., and a minimum of two switching moves to industries and interchange connections are made each day. It also serves the City of Chicago through the medium of the various switching carriers.

Fast and frequent passenger service is operated between all communities along the rail line and to the City of Chicago, by direct connection with Chicago Transit Authority trains at Forest Park, Illinois.

The total trackage owned is 96.33 miles, which includes 77.27 miles of main line tracks. Carload freight team tracks are provided at 16 different and convenient locations, having a total capacity of 87 cars.

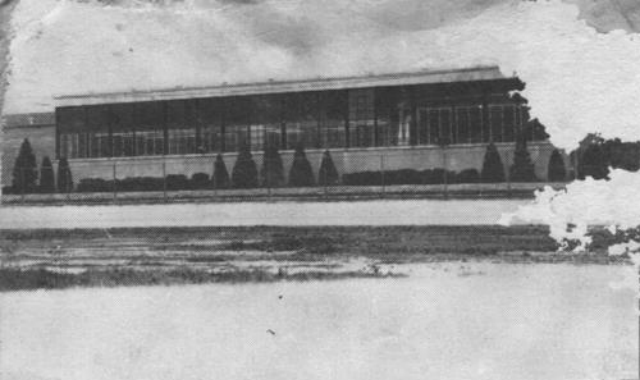

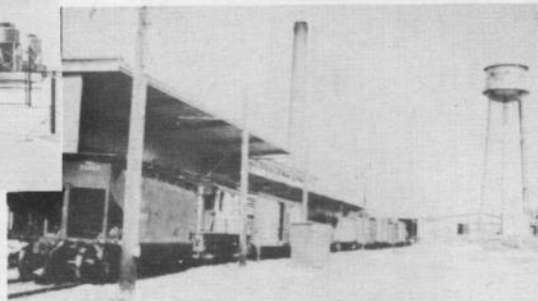


Direct Carload Freight Service

The Hillside Quarry development for the production of building stone originally was started in the year 1885. Later, the production of crushed stone was commenced and carried on thru the years. This stone is produced in varying sizes and supplies the needs for miles around for concrete building construction, water bound and asphalt macadam bound roads, concrete roads, fertilizer and railroad ballast to list a few of its many uses.

Limestone dust is also produced at this plant. A few of its uses are coal mine dusting, the manufacture of asphalt shingles, asphalt paving, asbestos piping, etc.

Stone produced at this operation supplies a concrete ready mix plant on the site, as well as two asphalt plants and a concrete sewer pipe manufacturer.

Stone produced from this location has contributed greatly to the development of Chicago and its metropolitan area.

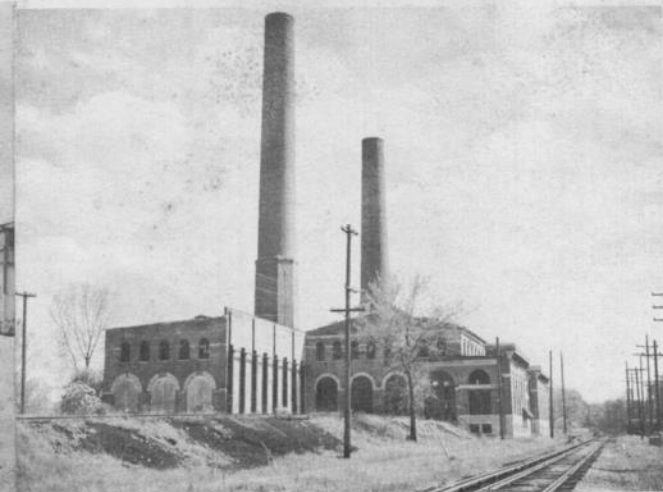
Typical Carload Freight Interchange
