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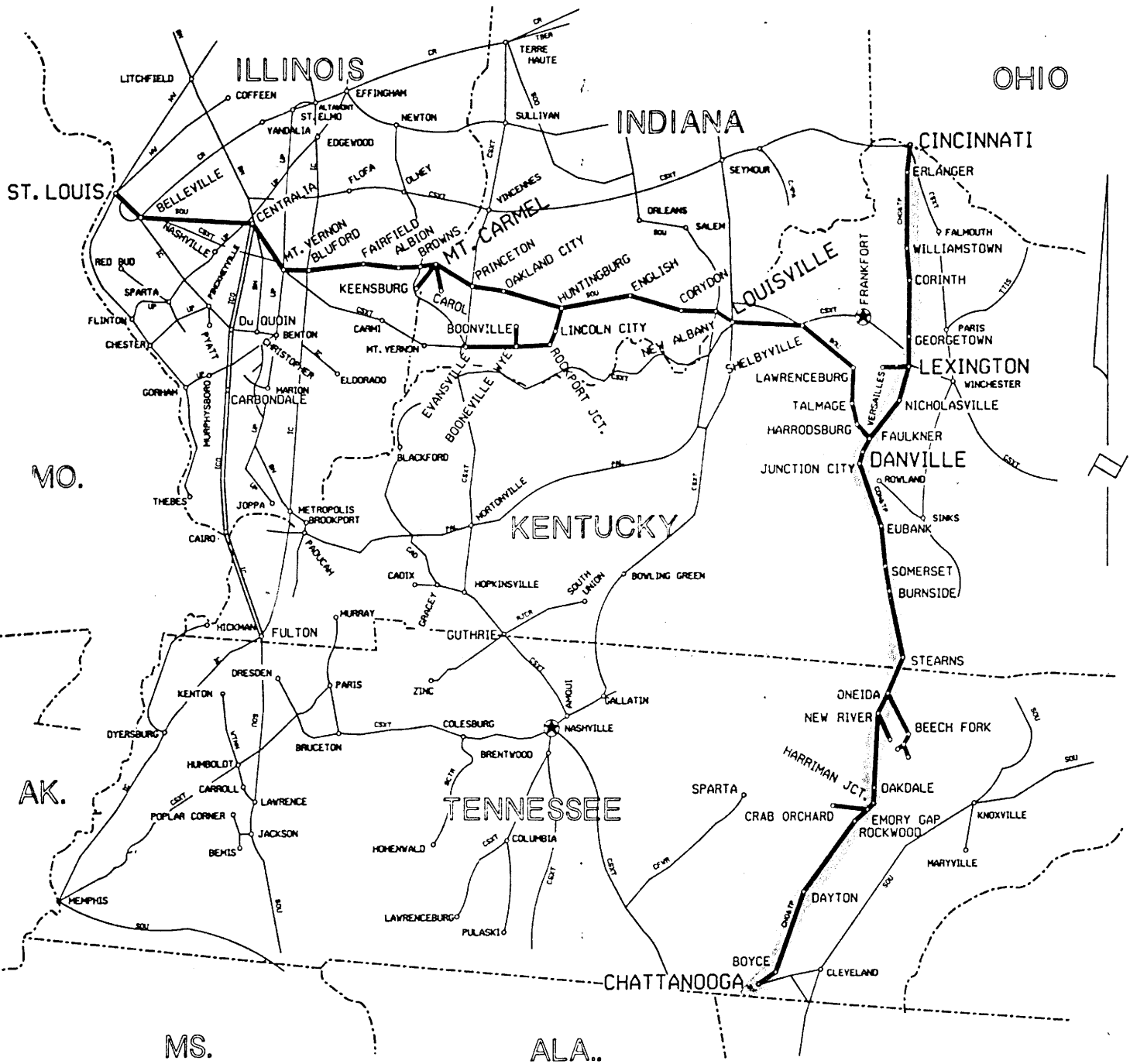
The Kentucky Division officers and its employees welcome you to the CNO&TP Railway.

CNO&TP trains operate over a traffic control system between Cincinnati, Ohio, and Chattanooga, Tennessee a distance of 338 miles. The CNO&TP Railway is an integral part of the Norfolk Southern Corporation and operates 56 freight trains and 20 yard engines. A total of 468 train and engine service employees man the trains and yard engines on the CNO&TP segment of the Kentucky Division.

In addition to CNO&TP main line, short line operations exist as follows: Oneida to Devonia, Tennessee, 41.5 miles; Helenwood to Sterling, Tennessee, 11.0 miles; Harriman to Crab Orchard, Tennessee, 24.2 miles and the North Chattanooga spur, 10.0 miles.

Two major yards are located at Cincinnati and Danville. Several smaller yards are located at Delaplain, Lexington, Somerset, Oneida and Emory Gap. A total of 124 non-operating personnel support train operations on CNO&TP segment of the Kentucky Division.
