Miscellaneous Instructions

Position in Freight Train or Mixed Train of Cars Containing Explosives:

In a freight train or mixed train a car placarded "explosive" shall, when the length of the train permits, be placed not nearer than the sixteenth car from both the engine or caboose except when the length of the train will not permit it shall be placed near the middle of the train.

Position in Train of Loaded Placarded Tank Car:

In a freight train or mixed train a placarded loaded tank car shall, when the length of the train permits, be not nearer than the sixth car from the engine or caboose. When the length of the train will not permit, it shall be not nearer than the second car from the engine or caboose.

Separating Loaded Tank Cars Placarded "Dangerous" from other Cars in Train:

In a freight train or mixed train a placarded loaded tank car must not be handled next to: Any car placarded "Explosive," engine, occupied caboose, cars placarded "Poison", or open top car when any of the lading extends above the car ends and is shiftable.

Separating Cars Placarded "Explosive" from other Cars in Train:

In a freight train or mixed train a car placarded "Explosive" must not be handled next to: Any car placarded "Dangerous", engine, any car placarded "Poison", open top car when any of the lading protrudes beyond the car ends and is liable to shift. Cars with automatic refrigeration (Mechanical), cars containing lighted heaters, carloads of livestock, or occupied caboose.
