1. Weather conditions and temperatures shall be reported at least once in six hours by and recorded for at least one station on each dispatching district and shall be recorded for such other stations as report weather conditions.
2. Each train dispatcher shall sign his name and record the time of going on and off duty in the space provided.
3. The M. of C. of each district shall be reported at least once in six hours by and recorded for at least one station.
4. The number of cars in each train shall be shown at least at one station and at such other stations as the carrier may determine.
5. Going of trains passing reporting stations shall be recorded; where trains stop at reporting stations, both arriving and departing time shall be recorded.
